

Getting to the TIC

The University of Strathclyde, Technology and Innovation Centre (TIC)

NAPIC 2026 will take place at the University of Strathclyde, Technology and Innovation Centre (TIC), Glasgow, United Kingdom. Located in Glasgow, located in Glasgow City Centre and 18KM from Glasgow Airport, there are various convenient transport options available for guests travelling to the TIC. With modern event facilities, excellent space, and easy accessibility for delegates, it is the ideal venue to host a successful and engaging event.

Travel Options

Arrival by Air

The nearest major airport is Glasgow Airport, approx. 18 KM from the venue. Travel time taxi: approx. 20-25 minutes (depending on traffic) to the venue. There is no direct bus from the airport to the venue. One option is to go from the airport to Glasgow City Centre and walk to the venue from there. Another option is to catch the airport shuttle bus (e.g. FirstBus 500) to the city centre which runs frequently. This stops near Queen Street Station and is then an 8-10 minute walk to the venue. Approx. journey time: 20-30 minutes depending on traffic.

Arrival by Train

The venue is in Glasgow City Centre, within walking distance of major train stations.

- Glasgow Queen Street Railway Station – 7 minute walk from the venue.
- Glasgow Central Railway Station – 14-15 minute walk from the venue.
- High Street Railway Station – 4 minute walk from the venue.

Arrival by Bus

Buchanan Bus Station is approx. 10 minute walk from the venue.

Arrival by Subway

Buchanan Street Subway Station is an 8 minute walk from the venue.

Arrival by Car

The venue is located within **Glasgow's Low Emission Zone**, so please check vehicle compliance before driving. Nearby parking options include:

- Duke Street Car Park (24 hour) – Approx. 0.3 miles away from the venue.
- NCP Montrose Street Car Park – Approx. 0.2 miles away from the venue.

Arrival by Taxi

The distinctive Black Cabs can accommodate five or six people. If their yellow light is on, you can flag them down on the street. Alternatively, you can call +44 (0) 141 429 70

70 or visit the Glasgow Taxis website to book. You can also hail a taxi outside of Glasgow Airport.

Arrival by Rideshare/Uber

Services like Uber operate in Glasgow, providing another convenient option for reaching the venue. Download Uber via the Android / iPhone App, create an account, top up via debit/credit card and book a ride!

Name: The Clydeside Distillery

Info: Glasgow's whiskey renaissance begins with the Clydeside, it's first dedicated single malt distillery in over 100 years. If you are a fan of whiskey, The Clydeside Distillery is a must-see.

Name: Pollock Country Park and Burrell Collection

Info: Pollok Country Park is Glasgow's largest park and the only Park within Glasgow. Its extensive woodlands and gardens provide a quiet sanctuary for both visitors and wildlife. The park is rich in rural history formerly being part of the Old Pollok Estate and ancestral home to the Maxwell Family. The park is also home to the world famous Burrell Collection.

Name: Buchanan Street

Info: Buchanan Street is Glasgow's main pedestrianised shopping area and recognised as one of the top retail destinations in the UK. This half a mile shopping stretch is located in the heart of Glasgow's City Centre and is easy to reach by two subway stops.

Name: City Centre Mural Trail

Info: While in Glasgow don't miss out on seeing some of the city's most impressive creations of street art. Glasgow was named the 4th best city in the UK for street art (research by South Western Railway, Aug 2022). Huge murals can be found on the side of city buildings, which, put together, form the City Centre Mural Trail.

Name: The Finnieston Crane and River Clyde

Info: Take a moment while in Glasgow to marvel at the Finnieston Crane and River Clyde. It is one of four cranes by the River Clyde, and one of only eleven cantilever cranes left in the world. Its purpose was to lift heavy machinery including tanks and steam locomotives, onto ships coming in and out of the city for exports to the British Empire. It has not been in working order since 1988 but has remained a symbol of Glasgow's heritage.

Name: Gallery of Modern Art

Info: Found in the heart of Glasgow in Royal Exchange Square, GoMA is FREE to enter. Scotland's most popular contemporary art gallery features modern works from international artists, housed in a graceful neoclassical building. The original interior is used to make a daring, inventive art display.
